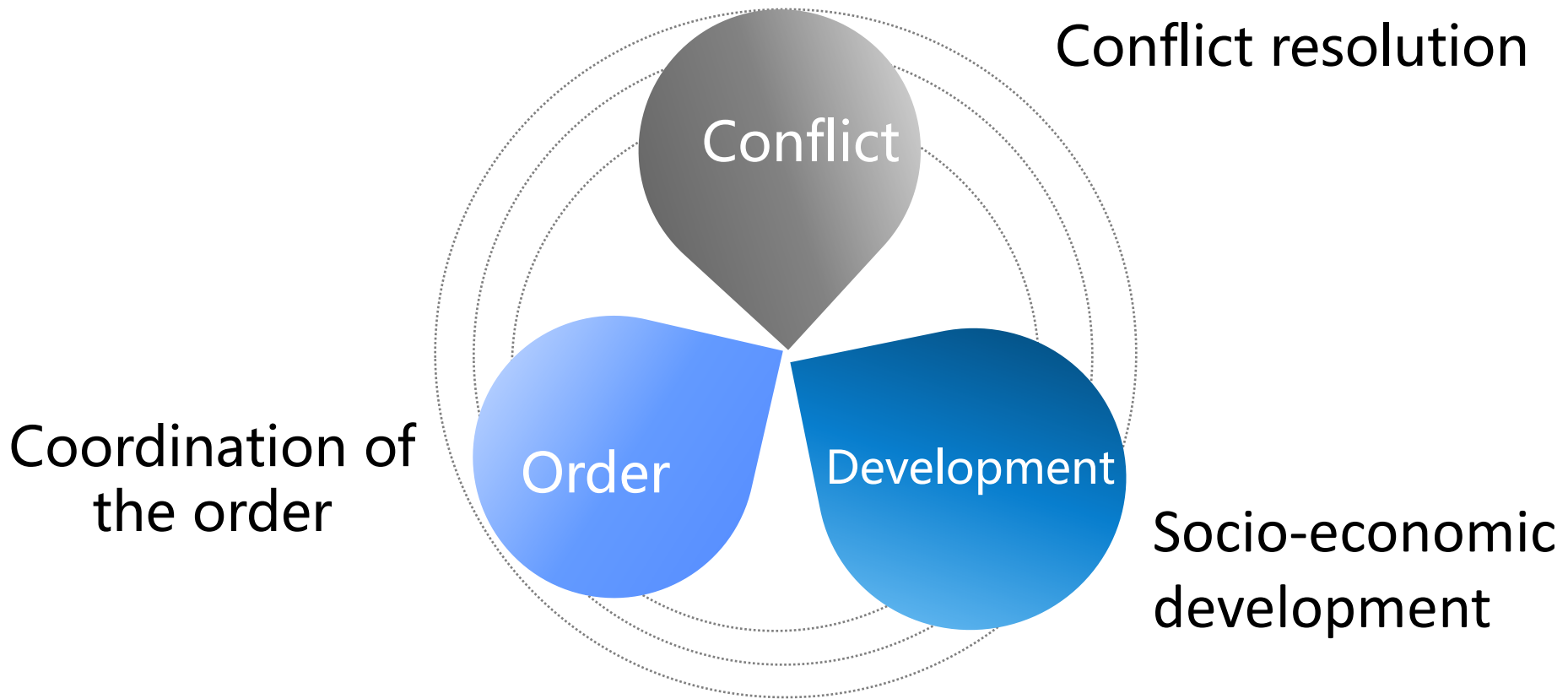

The Global Development Trend



Trend I

Continuous conflicts——International order will enter a relatively long period of collapse and reconstitution. A huge vacuum may occur to public governance at global level, conflict and disorder of a certain extent will become a kind of constant state.

Trend II

The more just international order will come——A kind of international governance and economic pattern which complies with the principle of equality and reciprocity, a global public field which shows more respect for diversification, a global order which can especially make an overall planning of sustainable development of most countries and especially show the idea of “share weal and woe” and “enjoy harmony in diversity” .

Characteristics of the Global Changes

International economy and international order enter the period for extensive adjustment. Conspicuous progress has been made in economic globalization and world multi-polarization. However, uneven resource distribution and profit distribution are obviously unfair, relatively uneven, and such trend tends to be expanded. The international political and economic pattern formed after the World War II is changing, the governance intention and ability from non-western power are conspicuously increased.

The increasingly severe global issues call for effective global governance system. The internationally traditional and non-traditional security issues are intertwined, the world's economic growth is weak, social extreme ideological trend rises, the great change in the Middle East, the Ebola epidemic in Africa, the European refugee tide, and even the violent terrorism which took place in Paris, France and etc., all hasten the birth of the new global governance system.

International consensus speeds up the step of the construction of the global governance system. The international society reaches a consensus in the issues such as promoting economic transformation and development, impelling UN 2030 development agenda and the climate change conference in Paris, cracking down on terrorism and etc. and converts them into action.

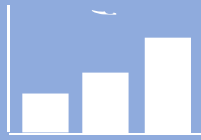

- Encourage emerging economies to be more active



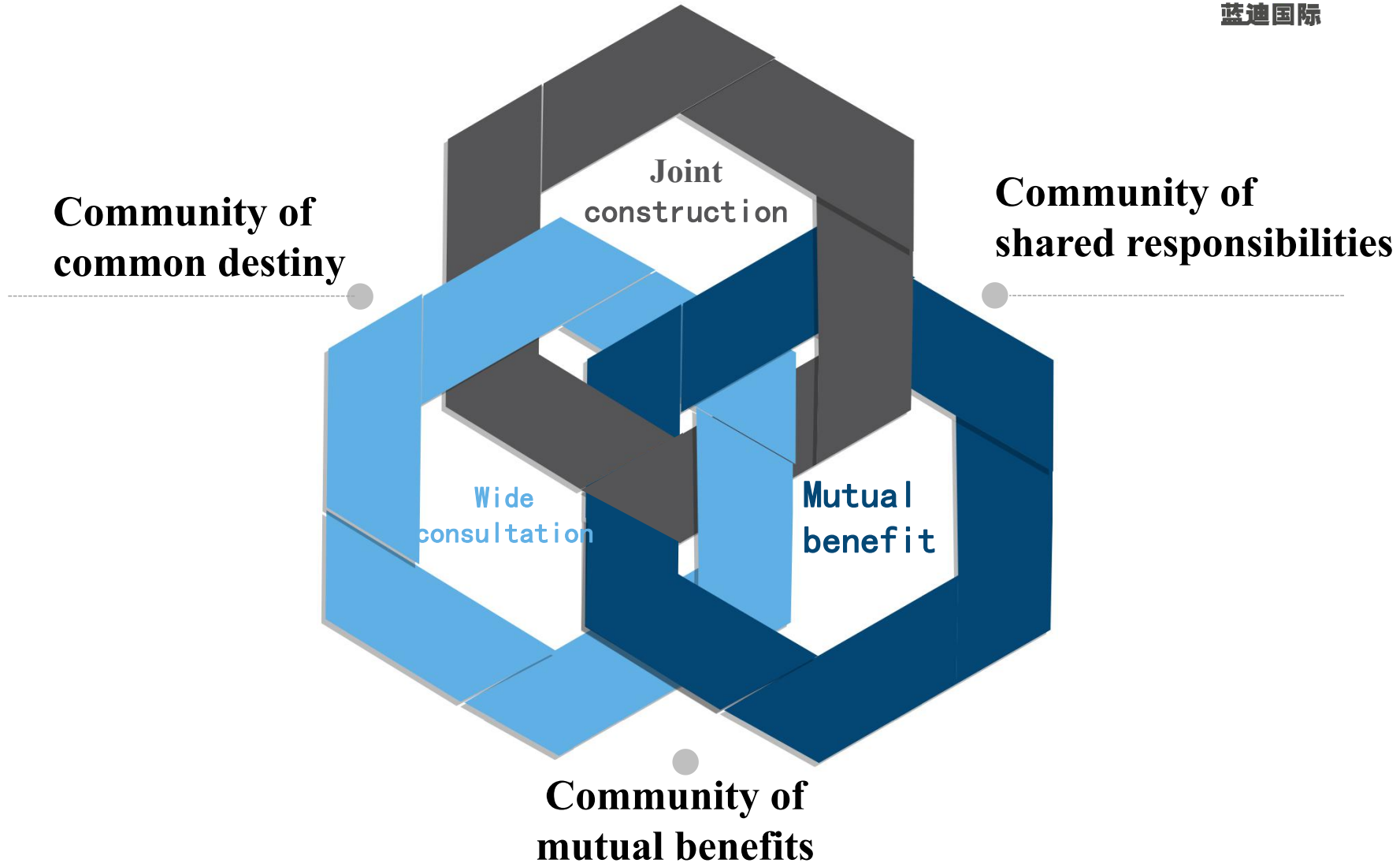

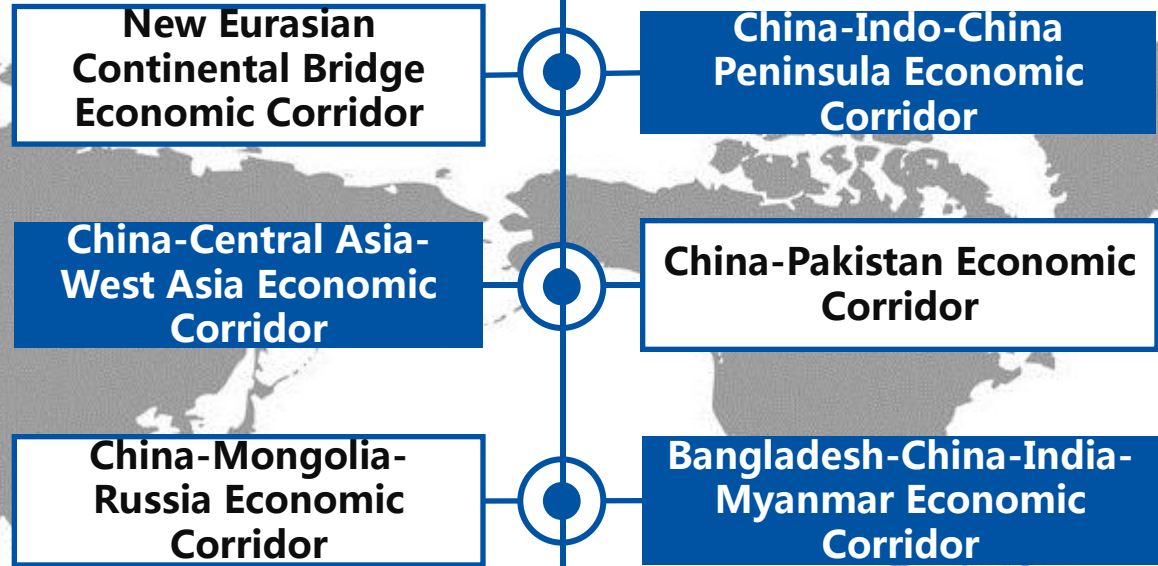
Key Areas in the OBOR Development

Key regions in the construction of "One Belt and One Road"



Onshore: Rely on international economic corridor, take central cities along the line as the support, take key economic and trade industrial park as the cooperation platform, and jointly build economic corridors for international cooperation

Offshore: Take key ports as the connection point, jointly build safe transportation corridor of high efficiency.

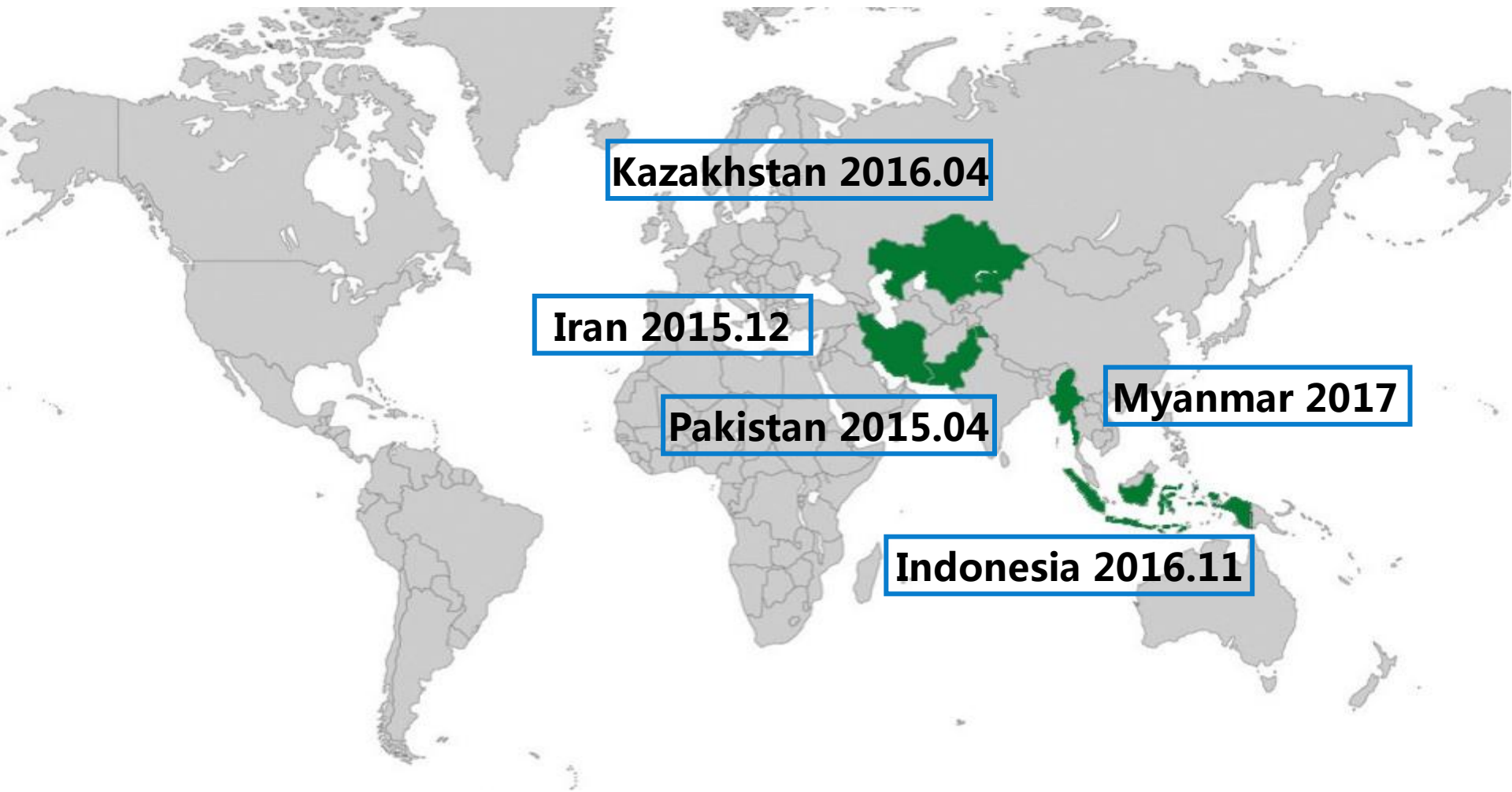
Demand-Oriented Service Mechanism
