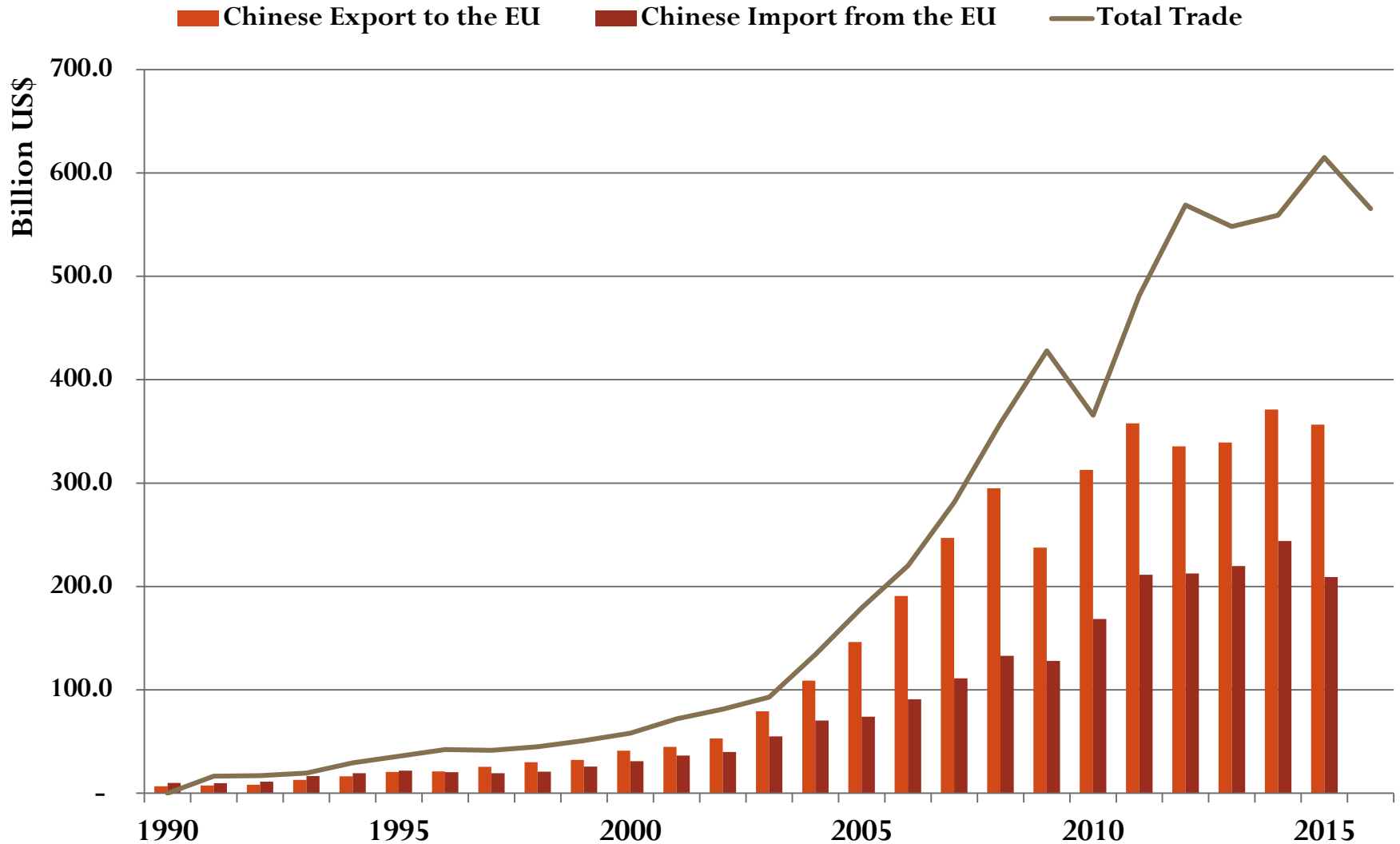

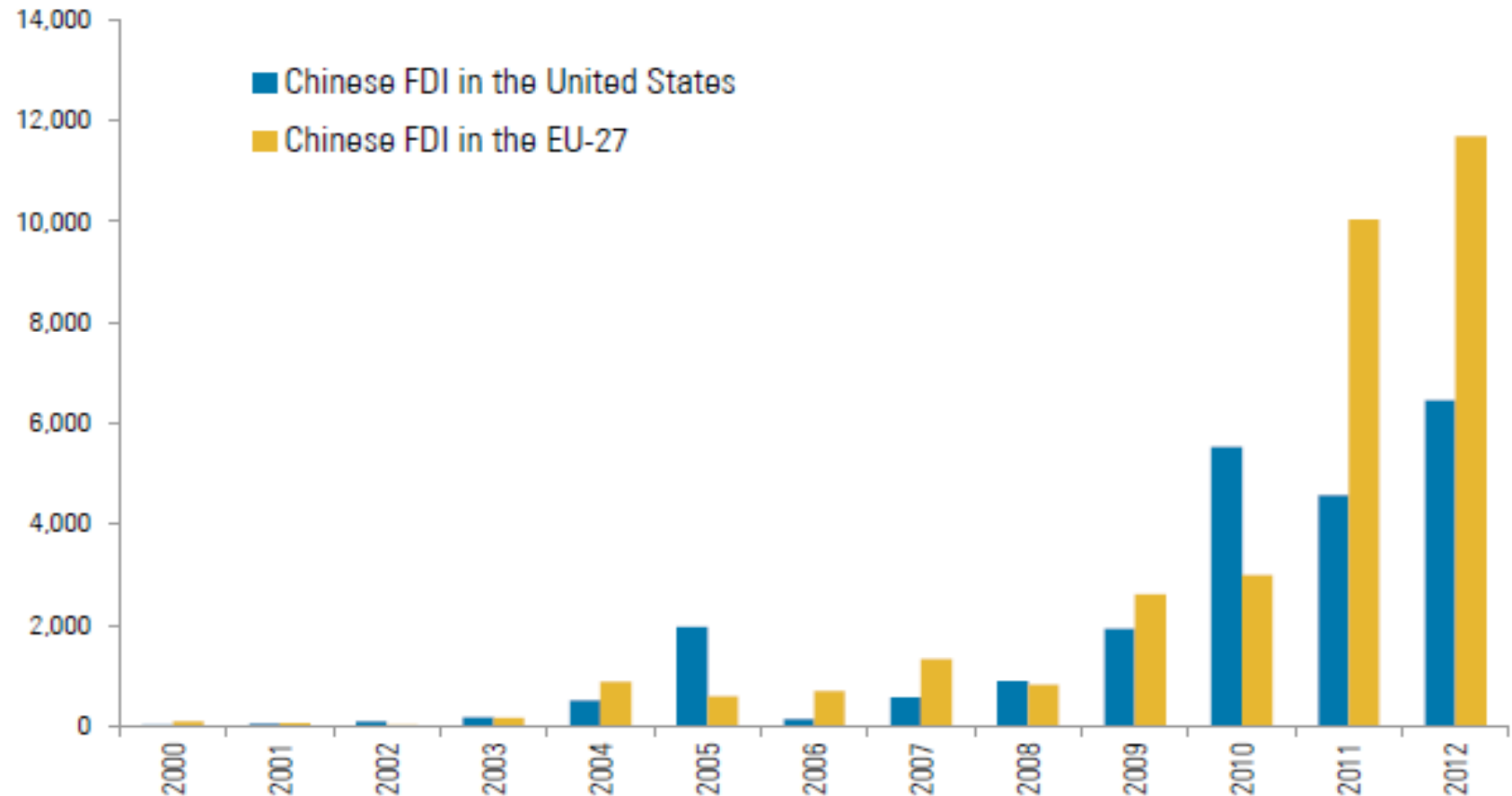

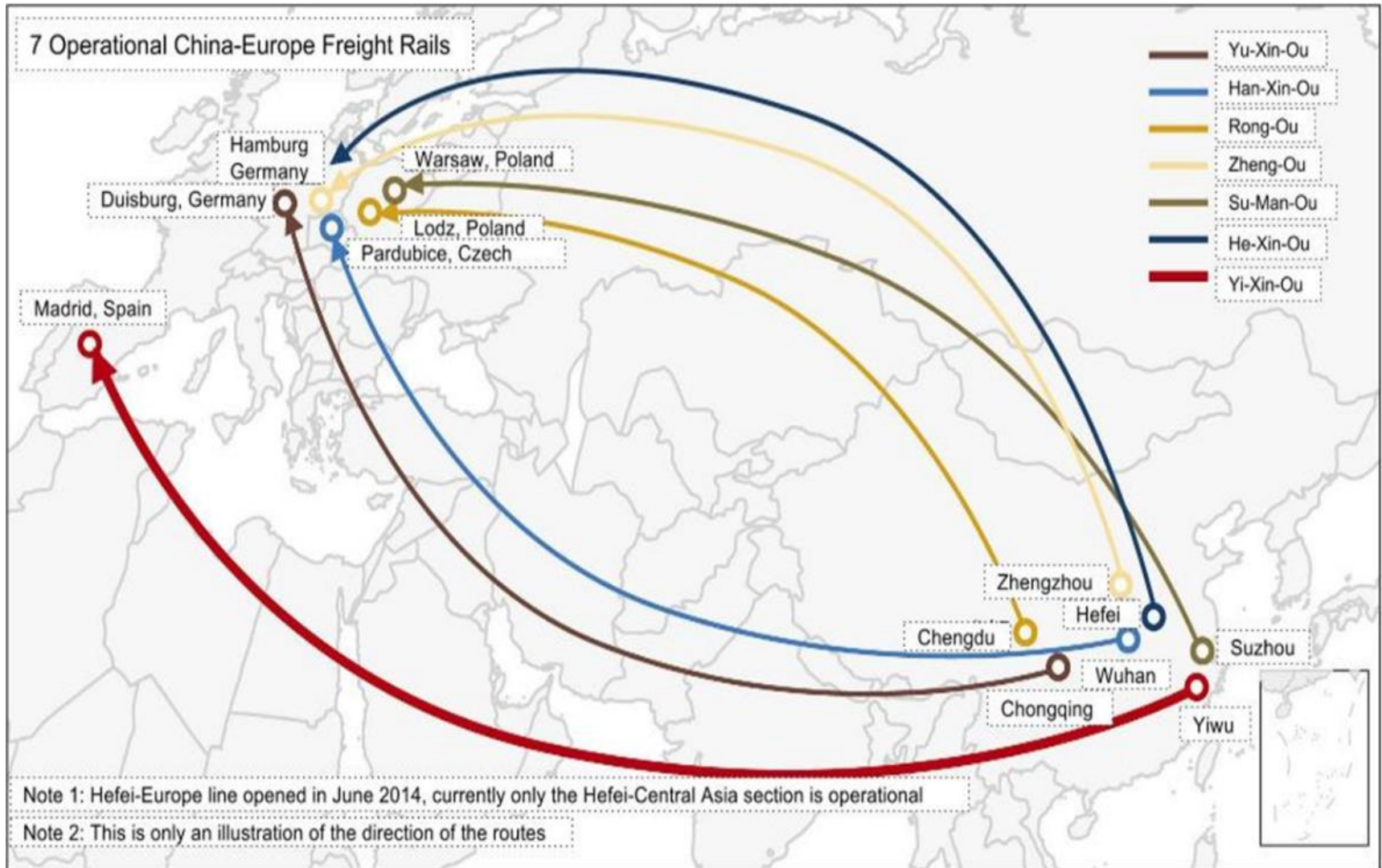
Figure I: Annual Chinese FDI Flows to the United States and European Union, 2000-2012
